# 1. Goals for this meeting

- \* CPAP scheduled to be signed at the end of 2011 between Ministry Planning and UNDP T&T



## 2. UNDP Country Programme

UNDP Country Programme 2012-2015:

- was developed in consultation with T&T Government during 2010 and 2011
- connects to four out of seven Pillars for of People's Partnership Manifesto which is Official Government Policy
- was endorsed by T&T Government in June 2011 UNDP Executive Board session in NY
- was approved in June 2011 UNDP Executive Board session by Exec Board



## 2. UNDP T&T Country Programme

Four outcomes for 2012-2015:

1. By 2015, T&T will have made progress in the formulation and application of targeted public policies to reduce poverty
2. By 2015, improved human security through implementation of evidence-based policies, strategies and practical initiatives
3. Increased environmental sustainability to achieve sustainable development through environmental management, compliance with international treaties, adaptation to climate change, and improvement in capacity for policy and strategy development
4. By 2015, mechanisms are enhanced for government institutions and processes to improve responsiveness and accountability to the general population through effective participation and dialogue involving all sectors of society (democratic governance)

### 3. WHAT IS THE CPAP ?

- CPAP= Action plan document to implement the Country Programme
- Describes country context, national development challenges, listing of planned initiatives
- A legal agreement between host government and UNDP to execute Country Programme for the period 2012 – 2015
- Mandatory instrument for UNDP, UNICEF and UNFPA in T&T



### 3. BENEFITS CPAP ?

- Efficiency: CPAP + annual work plan make sure project documents no longer needed
- Planning: Planning tool for Country Programme
- Effectiveness: Once signed monitoring tool for implementation UNDP Programme in T&T
- Consistency: UNDP, UNICEF, UNFPA all use CPAP documents



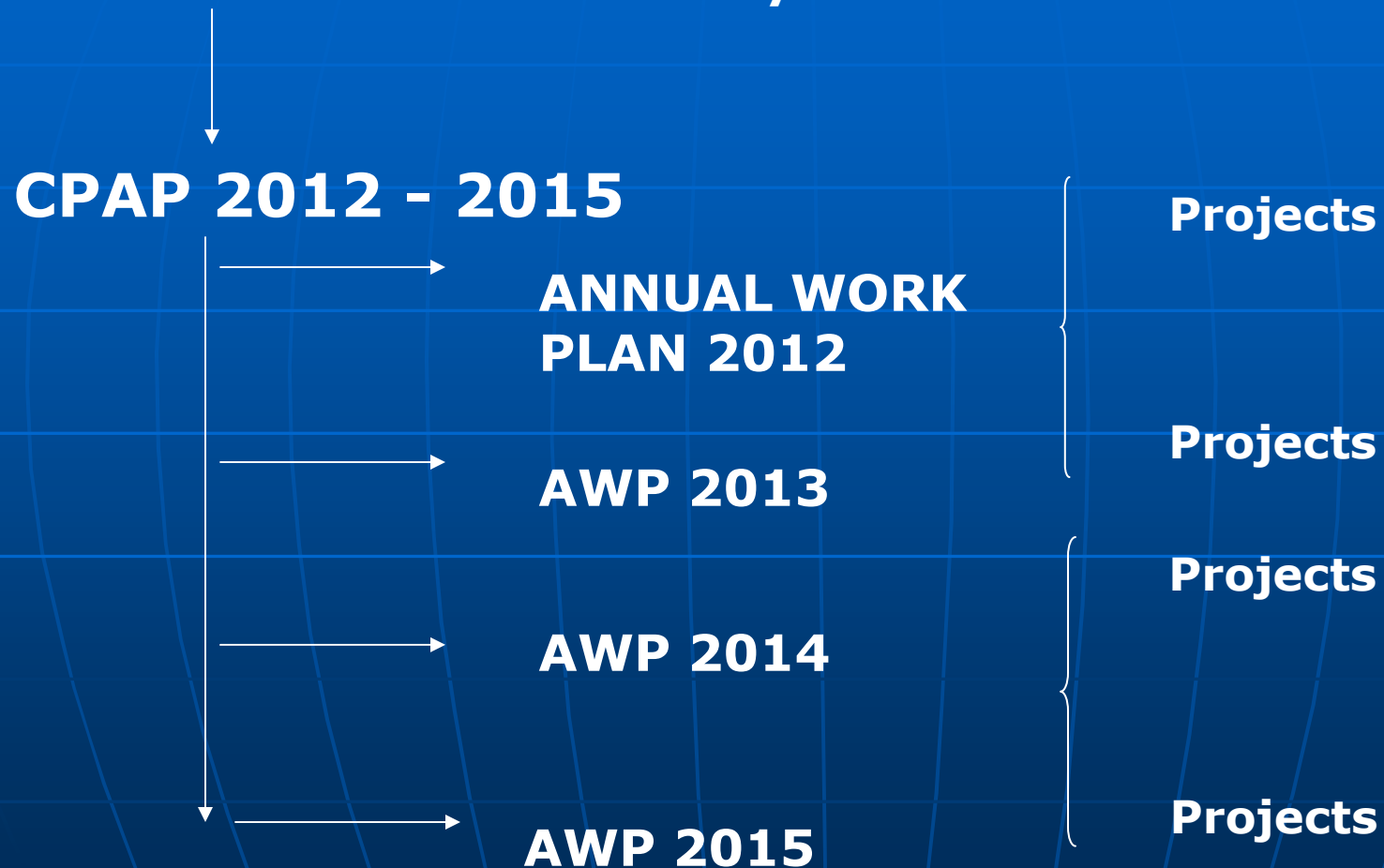
# WHAT ARE AWP's?

- AWP's are legal agreements between UNDP and Implementing Partners concerning specific projects
- The CPAP/AWP links outcomes and outputs in the CPD to activities which are articulated in the CPAP and AWP's.

# 4. UNDP MODUS OPERANDI: WHY WORK WITH UNDP?



- High quality development knowledge and advisory services.
- Globally proven methodologies with local solutions.
- Objective and Impartial
- Access to United Nations Volunteers
- A project based approach towards achievement of concrete development results including strong transparency and accountability mechanisms.
- Well defined business processes.
- Access to global Knowledge hubs and networks.
- Long-term Agreements with Academia, research institutions and private sector.
- Provides additional operational services (financial, procurement, administrative)

# 4. UNDP MODUS OPERANDI

- Examples T&T Development Results:
  - Helped to establish EMA, ODPM, etc
  - Off shore drilling locations
  - UNDP first major funder for Turtle Tourism Grand Riviere
  - Deployed well over 100 Medical Professionals in Health Institutions
  - Will publish in Nov 2011 UNDP Caribbean Human Development Report on Citizen Security

- UNDP work is done in development projects
- Projects are embedded in partners (Govt, Civil Society, Private Sector)
- (Institutional) Capacity Development and achievement of real development results at the forefront
- UNDP T&T office oversees projects, shares best practices and
